IN SPITE OF THE FACT THAT DESPITE THE FACT THAT	Nonostante che	In spite of the fact that/ Despite the fact that we tried to save him, he died.
IN SPITE OF (+ ING) DESPITE (+ING)	Nonostante che	In spite of/ despite trying to save him, he died.
IN SPITE OF THAT DESPITE THAT	Nonostante ciò	We tried to save him. <i>In spite of that/ despite that</i> he died.
IN SPITE OF (+ SOSTANTIVO) DESPITE (+ SOSTANTIVO)	Nonostante	In spite of/ Despite our efforts to save him, he died.

WHILE/WHEREAS	mentre	We tried to save him <i>while/whereas</i> his friend didn't bother.
IN CONTRAST	diversamente	Living in a big city can be tiring. <i>In contrast,</i> living in the country can be very relaxing.
ON THE CONTRARY	Al contrario	That dog looks peaceful. <i>On the contrary</i> , it is very aggressive.
ON THE OTHER HAND	D'altra parte (è usato quando si considera la stessa cosa da un altro punto di vista)	Computers save time. <i>On the other hand</i> , they are expensive.
