

- 1. Un titolo
- 2. Paragrafo di introduzione (preferibilmente con una domanda retorica alla fine per cogliere l'attenzione del lettore)
- 3. Elabora i tuoi vari punti in diversi paragrafi (di solito 2 o 3)
- 4. Paragrafo conclusivo in cui riassumi il tuo punto principale e esprimi la tua opinione.
- 5. A differenza del «report» qui si cerca un contatto con il lettore, si cerca di coinvolgerlo usando un linguaggio più informale.
