

CONNETTIVI DI CAUSA ED EFFETTO

- ESPRIMERE LA **CAUSA** DI UN FATTO/AZIONE

BECAUSE (=perché/poiché)	There were a lot of accidents <i>because</i> the roads are icy.
AS/SINCE (=poiché/siccome)	<i>As/Since</i> the roads are icy, there were a lot of accidents
FOR (=perché, visto che)	We've got to do shopping today, <i>for</i> the shops are closed tomorrow.

BECAUSE OF OWING TO → (=a causa di) DUE TO	There were a lot of accidents <i>because of/owing to/due to</i> the icy roads.
BE DUE TO (=essere causato da)	The accidents <i>were due to</i> the icy roads.

BECAUSE OF, OWING TO E DUE TO SONO PREPOSIZIONI E COME TALI NON SONO SEGUITI DA FRASE MA DA SOSTANTIVO O PRONOME

CONNETTIVI DI CAUSA ED EFFETTO

- ESPRIMERE LA **CONSEGUENZA/EFFETTO** DI UN FATTO/AZIONE

SO (=così)	We are destroying lots of species of plants so we will not be able to produce medicines.
AS A RESULT AS A CONSEQUENCE → (=di conseguenza) CONSEQUENTLY	<i>The road are icy. As a result/ as a consequence/ consequently there are a lot of accidents.</i>
THEREFORE (=perciò)	The roads are icy. Therefore , there are a lot of accidents.

SI METTE LA VIRGOLA DOPO «THEREFORE»

CONNETTIVI DI CAUSA ED EFFETTO

- ESPRIMERE IL RAPPORTO TRA **CAUSA ED EFFETTO** (così...che...)

SUCH A/AN + (AGGETTIVO) + SOSTANTIVO SINGOLARE NUMERABILE + THAT...	<i>It is such a lovely day that...</i>
SUCH + (AGGETTIVO) + SOSTANTIVO PLURALE O SOSTANTIVO SINGOLARE NON NUMERABILE + THAT...	<i>There will be such fast cars that...</i> <i>It was such lovely weather that...</i>
SUCH A LOT OF + SOSTANTIVO SINGOLARE O PLURALE + THAT...	<i>She ate such a lot of chocolates that...</i>
SO + AGGETTIVO/AVVERBIO + THAT...	<i>You will be so happy that...</i>
SO + MUCH/MANY/LITTLE/FEW + SOSTANTIVO SINGOLARE O PLURALE + THAT...	<i>There was so much traffic that...</i> <i>There were so many people that...</i>
