

CONNETTIVI DI «CONDIZIONE»

I PRINCIPALI CONNETTIVI PER ESPRIMERE CONDIZIONE SONO:

- **IF**= se

Es. *You won't pass the exam if you don't study hard.*

- **EVEN IF**= anche se

Es. *Even if I studied hard, I'm sure I wouldn't pass that exam.*

- **UNLESS (+ forma affermativa del verbo)**= se non, a meno che non

Es. *You won't pass the exam unless you study hard.*

(=*You'll pass the exam **only if** you study hard.*)

ALTRI CONNETTIVI PER ESPRIMERE CONDIZIONE SONO:

- **PROVIDED/PROVIDING (THAT)**= a patto che, purchè

Es. *We can have the party in the garden, provided/providing (that) it doesn't rain.*

- **AS LONG AS**=purchè

Es. *We can have the party in the garden, as long as it doesn't rain.*

- **SUPPOSE/SUPPOSING (THAT)**= supponi/supponendo che

Es. *Suppose you could spend a month on a tropical island. Where would you like to go?*

- **IMAGINE (THAT)**= immagina di/che

Es. *Imagine you could spend a month on a tropical island. Where would you like to go?*

- **ON CONDITION THAT**= a condizione che

Es. *I'll come to your party on condition that John is invited, too.*

- **IN CASE OF (+ SOSTANTIVO)** = in caso di

Es. *In case of emergency (=If there is an emergency) call this number.*

- SCRIVI UNA SECONDA FRASE CHE ABBIA LO STESSO SIGNIFICATO DELLA PRIMA FRASE USANDO DA DUE A CINQUE PAROLE COMPRESO LA PAROLA FORNITA.

(**IF**) → Don't invest in shares _____ to lose.

2. If you don't take a taxi, you will be late for your appointment.

(**UNLESS**) → You will be late for your appointment _____ a taxi.

3. She must apologise to me or I won't forgive her.

(**UNLESS**) → I won't _____ apologises.

4. I can hear you only if you shout.

(**UNLESS**) → I can't _____ shout.

5. We will be having a garden party on Sunday, unless it rains.

(**PROVIDED**) → We will be having a garden party on Sunday, _____ rain.

6. If there is an accident, call the police.

(**IN CASE OF**) → _____ call the police.

KEY WORD TRANSFORMATION (FCE)

- SCRIVI UNA SECONDA FRASE CHE ABBIA LO STESSO SIGNIFICATO DELLA PRIMA FRASE USANDO DA DUE A CINQUE PAROLE COMPRESO LA PAROLA FORNITA.

1. Don't invest in shares unless you can afford to lose.

(IF) → Don't invest in shares **IF YOU CAN'T AFFORD** to lose.

2. If you don't take a taxi, you will be late for your appointment.

(UNLESS) → You will be late for your appointment **UNLESS YOU TAKE** a taxi.

3. She must apologise to me or I won't forgive her.

(UNLESS) → I won't **FORGIVE HER UNLESS SHE** apologises.

4. I can hear you only if you shout.

(UNLESS) → I can't **HEAR YOU UNLESS YOU** shout.

5. We will be having a garden party on Sunday, unless it rains.

(PROVIDED) → We will be having a garden party on Sunday, **PROVIDED (THAT) IT DOESN'T** rain.

6. If there is an accident, call the police.

(IN CASE OF) → **IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT** call the police.
