

PER ESPRIMERE SCOPO (per, allo scopo di, così da/così che...) si usa:

- **INFINITO** (TO.../**NOT TO**....)

*I went to England **to** improve my English.*

*I studied for hours **not to** fail the exam.*

- **IN ORDER TO/ IN ORDER** **NOT TO** + FORMA BASE

*I went to England **in order to** improve my English.*

*I studied for hours **in order not to** fail the exam.*

- **SO AS TO/SO AS** **NOT TO** + FORMA BASE

*I went to England **so as to** improve my English.*

*I studied for hours **so as not to** fail the exam.*

PER ESPRIMERE SCOPO (per, allo scopo di, così da/così che...) si usa:

- **SO THAT + SOGGETTO + WILL/CAN** (riferimento al presente o futuro)

I've just given him some money so that he will/can buy something to eat.

- **SO THAT + SOGGETTO + WOULD/COULD** (riferimento al passato)

I gave him some money so that he would/could buy something to eat.
